DEAR COLLEAGUES,

This year saw submissions of 92 projects from 29 countries for connecting cottbus. Our jury selected 12 of them, one will be presented as "coco Special Pitch Award": exciting stories that are likely to mature in Cottbus into competitive films. Let's come together for the 16th time in Cottbus and kick off some more beautiful films for our audiences.

Touring around the international festivals over the past year, the Polish IDA and the Croatian-Serbian THE PRIEST'S CHILDREN (coco 2011) are two really different films from Eastern Europe that have succeeded in appealing to a large international audience. Both productions show that it is possible to overcome the divide between the commercial and arthouse cinema and, above all, that Eastern European cinema really doesn't have to only be "niche cinema".

At the same time, the current political developments have resulted in a loss of image for Eastern Europe as a region: the armed conflict in the east of Ukraine and repressive measures in Russia – including the arrest of the Ukrainian director Oleg

Sentsov and the ban on the use of swearwords in films – confirm unpleasant clichés about the stagnation of progress in civil society within Eastern Europe.

These uncertainties are contrasted by developments in other East European countries, which have a positive effect on East-West coproductions. Production incentives offer financial stimuli for co-productions. Two important regional film funding instruments were established with the creation of the Sarajevo City of Film Fund and the Italian-Slovenian-Croatian "Re-Act" Fund. The Sarajevo City of Film Fund and the World Cinema Fund are among the five European funds that have received financial support from Creative Europe MEDIA for funding schemes that aim at enabling more European producers to step into international co-productions. Initiatives such as the St Petersburgbased "Point of View" Fund are further encouraging developments providing East European producers with new, additional funding opportunities which can help them to work in the market in a freer and more versatile way.

This year will see connecting cottbus organising a forum for the 16th time to discuss these and other important issues. Workshops and case studies on audience design, the further development of the Polish-German Co-Development Fund, and on the production and market careers of former coco projects offer the concrete basis for exploring ways of working together to tap new audiences and find financing models.

Last but not least, it is our main objective again to help launch interesting feature film projects. The Latvian-Greek-German coproduction MODRIS and the Kosovar-German THREE WINDOWS AND A HANGING are two recently completed coco projects screening in the past few months in the competitions at Sarajevo, Toronto and San Sebastian. Together with the Czech-Polish coco-project BELLA MIA, they will now be returning to Cottbus as part of the official festival programme.

We wish to express our heartfelt gratitude to our long-standing and new supporters and partners who have backed connecting cottbus financially as well as with advice and who have particularly enhanced our work for this year's edition with new aspects. We are looking forward to two days full of interesting projects, intensive discussions and new contacts.

COCO BEST PITCH AWARD

This year will see 13 creative teams from 12 countries vieing with one another at the annual project pitching forum to attract the interest of potential co-producers, financiers and commissioning editors for their projects. The professional audience at the forum will then vote for the most convincing presentation of a new project. The producer and director (or screenwriter) receive the \in 1,500 coco Best Pitch Award during the networking reception which is jointly hosted by Medienboard Berlin-Brandenburg and Mitteldeutsche Medienförderung. 2014 will be the second time that the award includes an accreditation for the award-winning producer to the "Producers Network" at the next Cannes Film Festival, sponsored by Producers Network Cannes.

COCO SPECIAL PITCH AWARD

Winning one of the main awards of the FilmFestival Cottbus is linked each year with the connecting cottbus Special Pitch Award. In 2013, the German director Thomas Sieben won the main prize of the German-Polish Youth Film competition with his film THE DAM. This year, we welcome his producer Jamila Wenske and him to pitch their new project.

COCO POST PITCH AWARD

For the fourth time, the post production company The Post Republic will be donating a colour correction and the production of a DCP for a suitable pitch project. The winner will be chosen by a three-person expert jury. This year, we are honoured that the producer Danijel Hocevar Vertigo/Emotionfilm, Jörg Schneider, commissioning editor at ZDF/Das Kleine Fernsehspiel, and Michael Reuter (The Post Republic) have agreed to serve on the jury.

COTTBUS CONNECTING DIVERSITY THE 24TH FILMFESTIVAL COTTBUS EXPLORES EASTERN EUROPEAN FILMS BETWEEN NATIONAL HITS AND INDEPENDENT CINEMA

From November 4-9, the FilmFestival Cottbus is showing the whole variety of East European film-making for the 24th time. Three competitions and ten programme sections with 164 films from 35 countries invite viewers to a journey through Eastern Europe and beyond.

While the main competition mixes commercial and strict arthouse approaches, featuring a variety of styles from direct cinema and romantic dramas to war action movies, the 'Spectrum' section focuses on independent films which show artistic styles beyond any classification, and the "National Hits" section presents box-office hits from several Eastern European countries. The 'Focus' section sees the FilmFestival Cottbus continuing its cinematic exploration of East European diversity under the title of "queerEAST". Focusing on films about LGBTIQ issues in Eastern Europe, it explores a crucial issue when it comes to civil rights in this region. A special section will cast a spotlight on Ukraine as a film region, while the 'global EAST' section looks for evidence of links in film-making between Eastern Europe and Italy.

The programme of the 24th FilmFestival Cottbus also features three films which were previously pitched at connecting cottbus and have been premiered at international film festivals this year. Participants of connecting cottbus have free entrance to the festival screenings during the duration of connecting cottbus.
